between the Norfolk and Suffolk sides of the river opens up new options for walks (Norwich and Southern Norfolk Groups have a joint figure of eight walk on 23rd September – a Norfolk walk in the morning and a Suffolk walk in the afternoon). It also provides an option for backpackers on the Angles Way to cross the river from Carlton Marshes to the campsite on the Norfolk side of the river. The ferry can take twelve passengers and the fare varies according to numbers.

In Memory of George Henry le Surf

George, born in Golders Green, London, on the 6th of September 1920, joined the Royal Navy as a boy sailor in 1936. He was serving on the battleship HMS Warspite at the outbreak of the Second World War and saw action in the North Atlantic and Mediterranean. Completing one of the Russian convoys to Murmansk he was then posted to Malta, joining one of the big convoys. After being torpedoed three times he was then transferred to minesweepers, then leaving the navy having completed twelve years as a chief petty officer.



After joining the National Fire Service in London and marrying in 1948, the Le Surfs made the move in 1956 up to Norfolk. George became Station Officer with the Norwich City Fire Brigade at Bethel Street where they lived in married quarters. Later with the help of fellow watch firemen George built the family home at Armes Street. After more than 20 years with the fire service he worked at the Stationery Office until formally retiring in the early 1980's.

Their love of the countryside blossomed but George and Jeanne found the footpaths mostly blocked, not mapped and very difficult to walk. The Armes Street home was to become for a time the Norfolk headquarters for footpath work. So began the task of improving Norfolk's footpath network. In the 1970's, with a group of stalwarts, the Norfolk Area of the Ramblers Association was launched, Jeanne was appointed County Footpaths Secretary and George took on the role of Norfolk Area Secretary, a post which he held for many years. They were honoured in 1976 by the Norwich & District Footpath Society which marked its 15th anniversary by awarding the first life memberships to Mr and Mrs le Surf. As a team Jeanne and George walked almost every known footpath in the county, known as Rambler, Jeanne compiled more than 2000 walks for the Evening News.

The le Surf husband and wife partnership campaigned for more than 50 years to improve Norfolk's footpath network. Becoming a formidable team, as Norfolk Ramblers forced action to tackle the backlog of blocked and overgrown footpaths and tracks. George represented the Ramblers at many public inquiries, and with Jeanne, a public voice was always to the forefront to further the aims of the RA. Protecting not only rights of way, but the beauty of the Norfolk countryside, in due course the le Surfs trained up a team of footpath secretaries to further the work they had started. The struggle still goes on but with the tireless work from George we now have a great advantage. The Norfolk Ramblers are listened to with respect; their voice is that of all walkers. On retirement from their positions with the Norfolk Ramblers George was made a vice president and Jeanne became president.

George passed away on the $4^{\rm th}$ of April 2012 aged 91, he leaves a widow, Jeanne; a daughter Jane, and a grandson Tom.
