# Your help is needed

The Ramblers need the help of its members in various activities other than or even together with walking. Here are several ways you can help.

We hope you have noticed publicity for the **Big Pathwatch**. It is a survey throughout England and Wales by which the Ramblers hope to learn more about the condition of public rights of way (Footpaths, Bridleways, Restricted Byways and Byways Open to All Traffic) from a walker's point of view. It involves people (the general public as well as members) walking all the paths within particular kilometre squares. The aim is to survey at least 30,000 squares throughout the country to be representative. In proportion in Norfolk the sample would need to be 1,100 squares. But over all of Norfolk there are enough squares for 3 or 4 per member, so please help. The only condition for taking part is that you have a mobile phone or have access to the internet, so please contact bigpathwatch@ramblers.org.uk

Publicity for the Ramblers at **Shows** around the County is already being undertaken this year at Worstead (25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> July), Sandringham Flower Show (29 July), Watton (Wayland 2<sup>nd</sup> August), Aylsham (31<sup>st</sup> August), Norfolk Showground (Wild About Norfolk 10th October). Various Groups have donated subscription money towards financing a rights of way specialist to put a case at a public inquiry about getting a public footpath on the Definitive Map of rights of way. There are a number of **potential claims for public paths** that are yet to be put together. All would require some local knowledge of both past and present users and possible difficulties. Some claims may be assisted by research into documents at both parish level and in the County Record Office.

Some members have already started to do the work necessary to make a claim in their locality. If anyone feels interested in assisting either locally or in the Record Office please contact Ian Mitchell as above.

Finally is there anybody not already on the Ramblers Norfolk Area rights of way sub-committee, but who would like to be? Or if not actually attending the sub-committee would be prepared to **inspect a path problem** in their locality – say within 5 miles or within 10 miles? Again contact Ian Mitchell as above.

**Planning applications** that might affect a public right of way are notified to us on a regular basis by only North Norfolk, South Norfolk and Breckland Councils. Would anyone like to take on looking at North Norfolk's applications? Or can anyone take on checking applications of one of the unspecified Councils? Again contact Ian Mitchell.

Finally probably all Groups would like **new leaders** to offer walks for their programme. One way to learn what is required is to go out with a leader who is checking out a walk, and on the day acting as rearguard for that leader. Contact any Group that you have been walking with.

## Footpath maintenance - an update

In the last newsletter, I gave a brief update on discussions which we - together with CPRE, Open Spaces Society and U3A - had been having with Norfolk County Council (NCC). These took the form of 3 workshops between us and relevant NCC staff from both Trails and Highways departments. These in turn led to the formulation of 13 specific proposals for NCC to consider, most for immediate consideration, but a small number requiring longer term consideration.

This work has now entered the NCC committee 'system'. The first presentation, made jointly by Tracy Jessop (NCC Assistant Director, Highways and Transport), Katy Jones (CPRE) and myself, was to the Norfolk Local Access Forum. This focused on the way in which the workshops had been developed, plus an account of the problems which prompted our original approach - notably poor maintenance of the rights of way network, and the absence of effective enforcement when paths were obstructed (especially by ploughing or cropping). The same 'team' repeated the exercise with the Environment, Development and Transport (EDT) Committee on 15 May, with a stronger emphasis on these problems. The minutes of this meeting are awaited, but the concerns - and the proposals to make changes - were well received by most of those present.

As I write, the plans are being incorporated into the Rights of Way Improvement Plan and its accompanying Action Plan, both of which go to the EDT Committee for approval on 10 July. After that, it will be a case of monitoring for implementation.

# West Norfolk Walkaway 4, Walk 9: Holme Hale and North Pickenham an apology and a correction

It has been brought to our attention that some wording in the instructions for this walk may suggest that there is public access to Houghton Springs. We would like to emphasise that this is not the case. If you hold a copy of our booklet, please amend it (page 19, point 2) by deleting the sentence beginning "Immediately opposite ... on the lakes.", and in the following sentence, delete the words "does not include this diversion but". Holders of older OS maps (both hard copy and for GPS) may see that a path to Houghton Springs is indicated as a public footpath, but this is an error, corrected in later versions. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by walkers who sought to access Houghton Springs as a result of the wording in our instructions.
